Please note appointments are for 20 minutes. Sanco's booking policy is on their website which gives you all the details you need to visit Sanco safely and seamlessly. Parents/Carers with appointments will be allowed into the store at your scheduled time. Anyone without an appointment will be asked to queue and Sanco will only be able to serve them in between parents/carers who have appointments.

Making Early Arrangements

It is very important to organize uniform **early**.

You are strongly urged to arrange uniform in **June or July**, and by **31 July** at the latest. If left till August, you may have to queue, or the items or sizes required may not be immediately available in case stock runs out.

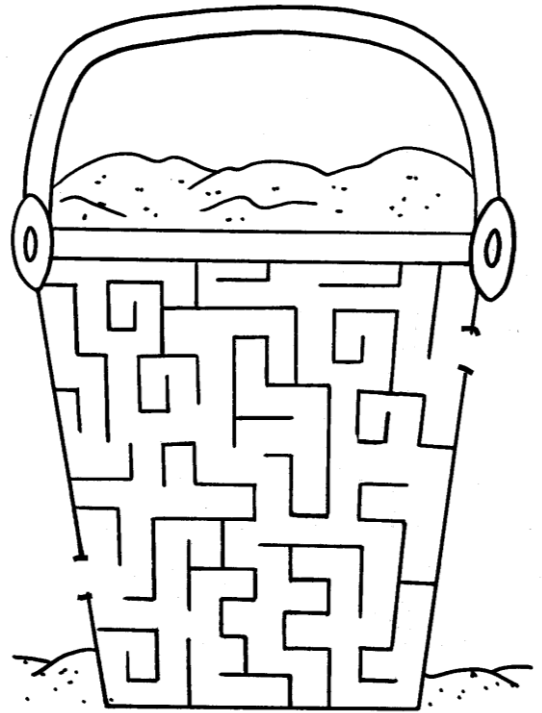
