With this in mind, we will be holding a ‘*Whole School*’ collection days on:

Wednesday 3rd and Thursday 4th December 2025

All children are asked to bring in items *if you are in a position to do so*.

All items are welcomed; however, below you will see some direction for each year group, as we would like to provide families with a variety of items:

Nursery - Hygiene / Cleaning products

Reception - Tinned Foods / Pasta and Sauces / sweet treats

Year 1 – Pasta, Sauces, and Tinned Meats

Year 2 – Cooking Sauces - Chopped Tomatoes (Tinned)

Year 3 - Hygiene Products / Spices / Breakfast Cereals

Year 4 - Breakfast Cereals / Tins of food

Year 5 - Sweet treats e.g. Biscuits / Tinned Meats (Tuna)

Year 6 - Tea, Coffee, Sugars, Oils, and Long life products (Milk) and Sweet treats


