Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to make you aware of some ongoing tensions between groups of older young people in neighbouring areas.

While these issues are not directly linked to primary-aged children, we believe it is important to keep you informed and to offer reassurance. Our priority, alongside the school, is the safety and wellbeing of all pupils.

You may notice an increased police presence in the local area, particularly at the start and end of the school day. This is a preventative measure to provide reassurance and ensure children remain safe.

We kindly ask parents and carers to:


- Ensure children are collected promptly where possible
- Remind children to come straight home after school
- Supervise use of mobile phones, messaging apps and online gaming platforms
- Report any concerns or information to the school or local police


Although primary school children are not involved, we know that older siblings or community conversations can sometimes cause worry. Please reassure your child that adults are aware of the situation and are working together to keep everyone safe.


If you have any concerns or notice anything unusual, do not hesitate to contact the school or your local Safer Neighbourhood Team.
